1st-Each month the Council offers "SAFETY BREAKfast Meetings" on various safety topics. 2nd-The Council is scheduling open enrollment "Safety Training". 3rd-The Council provides "On-site training" for members upon request.

NEW! "Illinois Safety Council Safety Awards Program"

"Free ISC Membership by Using the ISC Safety Video Library-Over 300 Titles"

Another member benefit is the Illinois Safety Council has one of largest safety video libraries in the country. The Council has over 28 categories of video's and over 300 titles. Members have a yearly credit for videos equal to the amount of their annual Council dues. After the credit is exhausted, the rental fee is \$30. The non-member video rental fee is \$50.
