Fleet and Transportation Outstanding Safety Performance Award

This recognition is based on improvement by competing against your own past record. Minimum number of vehicles to qualify as a fleet-five. This information is confidential.

31 entries were submitted. 22 ISC members qualified.

Safety Awareness Focus on Excellence Award: “S.A.F.E.”

The new “S.A.F.E. Award” recognizes organizations committed to promote a positive safety culture. The “Safety Awareness Focus” of an organization is exemplified in the activities that are chosen by management to support. To qualify the safety efforts undertaken are detailed. These activities demonstrated employee involvement and were part of an overall culture of safety awareness within the organization.
